

# PROPOSED BYLAWS CHANGES

May 2010

## 4.2.2 Courtesy Staff

- Have ability to vote on committees

## 4.2.3 Consulting Staff

- Have vote on committees (not required to serve)

## 4.2.4 Associate Staff

- Be required to pay dues
- Not eligible to vote or hold Medical Staff Office
- Serve on committees with vote

## 4.2.5 Senior Staff

- Serve on committees with vote
- Required to pay dues

## 4.2.6 Retired Staff

- Will not be required to pay dues
- May serve on committees with vote

## 4.2.7 Emeritus Staff

- Will not be required to pay dues
- May serve on committees with vote

## 4.2.8 Affiliate Staff

- To include ALL licensed healthcare professionals, therefore eliminating need for Allied Manual
- May serve on committees with vote
- Be required to pay dues as set by MSEC

## 7.3.2 and 7.3.3 Temporary Privileges – Important Patient Care Need and Pending Application

- Duration changed to be in compliance with DNV to max of 30 days unless extended by Board of Directors for up to two additional 30 day periods.

## 7.7 Locum Tenens

- New section to allow for locum tenens up to 120 days each 12 months after which would need to apply to medical staff.

## 11.9.4 Summary Suspension – Procedural Rights

- Requires MSEC or ad hoc committee of MSEC to rule on potential modification or termination of summary suspension within 72 hours. Must also request appearance by medical staff member.
- Requires same time for decision by Board of Directors or ad hoc committee after decision by MSEC

# 11.10.1 Automatic Suspension and/or Loss of Membership - License

- Clarifies ability to do administrative suspension when action taken against provider prohibiting him/her from practicing

## 11.10.4 Exclusion from Federal Health Program

- Allows provider to continue to practice IF able to outline practice plan that will ensure he/she will not be caring for any patients in program from which they are eliminated (Medicare or Medicaid usually)
