Influenza vaccination is the primary method for preventing influenza and its severe complications. Healthcare providers can acquire influenza from patients or transmit influenza to patients and other staff.

NYS Department of Health mandates healthcare institutions, including Crouse Hospital, to comply with influenza transmission prevention guidelines.

All Crouse Hospital employees, admitting physicians and adult volunteers are highly encouraged to receive a flu vaccine or will be required to wear a mask in patient care areas. Students volunteering or interning at the hospital who have direct patient care contact are also encouraged to receive a flu vaccine.
