**COVID-19 Reporting and Quarantine/Isolation**

Students mandated to be quarantined or isolated per county health departments must adhere to the following procedure:

- Students must notify the Assistant Dean for Faculty via email or phone when being tested for COVID-19 and report testing results
  - Students that test positive are expected to comply with contact tracing as requested by College administration and county health departments
- Students must provide a copy of their quarantine order to the Assistant Dean for Faculty immediately upon receipt of such order
- Students are not permitted to be onsite at the College or in clinical for the duration of the quarantine order
- In their student capacity, the policy of the College and Crouse Health is that the students are considered non-essential
- Students are permitted to attend remote sessions (i.e. theory lectures via ZOOM) if they choose
- College administration and course faculty will determine a plan with the student to make-up any missed coursework
- College administration reserves the right to not allow students to attend clinical or be onsite in the event the student is displaying COVID-19-like symptoms or has had a known exposure
- Failure to comply with this procedure will result in disciplinary action up to and including suspension or dismissal from the program
