Re: **Covid Update**

Due to the current increase of Covid-19 cases in Onondaga County, and to ensure the safety of our guests and staff, we are requiring all Crouse Health Tribute Evening attendees to comply with one of the following:

- Proof of vaccination. Vaccination is two initial doses of Moderna or Pfizer vaccine *or* one dose of the J&J vaccine.
OR
- Proof of a negative Covid test prior to the event (PCR within 72 hours, or an antigen test within 24 hours). At home tests will not be accepted.

Proof of vaccination can be submitted in advance via email to Jeff Loope, Donor Information Coordinator, Crouse Health Foundation, JeffreyLoope@crouse.org until **5 p.m. on Thursday, April 28th**. Vaccination verification after this deadline will be done upon entrance to Tribute Evening. Acceptable form includes a photo of vaccination card *or* New York State COVID-19 Vaccination Excelsior Pass. If you have any questions, please contact Jeff, 315-470-8076 or me, 315-470-7008.

Proof of negative test results will need to be available at the time of entrance to the Nicholas J. Pirro Convention Center, The Oncenter.

Please note that in accordance with current Onondaga County recommendations, mask wearing is optional and at your personal discretion. Crouse is committed to the health and safety of our community; please consider your personal health needs when choosing to attend the event.
